

ANTI-RAGGING

Ragging refers to an act that violates the dignity of a person. There have been many complaints of physical and psychological injury due to ragging in colleges and educational institutions. Nowadays, it has been turned to a nightmare to students and their guardians at the time of admission. The Anti-Ragging cell of our college consists of the following members:

As our college is a single faculty college affiliated to University of Mumbai and as per the regulations of UGC we have put in place several stringent mechanisms to check ragging on campus, including anti-ragging cells, discipline committees and information campaigns conducted by the NSS, WDC, Cultural and other committees. We follow the following procedures to curb ragging activities in our premises.

BEFORE AND DURING ADMISSION:

- a) Our instruction booklet contains Anti-Ragging regulations in full.
- b) Telephone numbers of the Anti-Ragging Helpline and all the important functionaries in the institution, members of the Anti-Ragging Committees are published in the prospectus and also displayed prominently on main locations in the college and also displayed on the college website www.mmk.edu.in
- c) Every student and his/her parents give an undertaking vowing not to indulge in ragging. It contains the name, address and telephone numbers of the parents of the senior students.
- d) The institution prominently displays posters detailing laws and punishment against ragging.

AFTER ADMISSION:

- a) Students are warned "in plain words" against ragging during the orientation programme at the outset of the academic year. Anyone caught ragging a student will face harsh punishment, even suspension or jail term.
- b) The entire college is covered by CCTV cameras to keep a constant vigil on students and their activities.
- c) Anti-ragging committee ensures vigil constantly during the college hours during first few months inside institution premises.
- d) Freshers are informed about our college website that contains detailed addresses and telephone numbers of the Anti-Ragging Committee Members and relevant district and police authorities.
- e) Faculty members make surprise visits and do interaction with the freshers.

- f) Two Constables from Khar Police Station are stationed outside the college premises for the first three months to look into the incidents happening in the area surrounding our institution. They also take rounds inside the college premises constantly.
- g) Periodic meetings of Anti-Ragging Committee are held with the Head of the Institution and necessary steps are taken.
