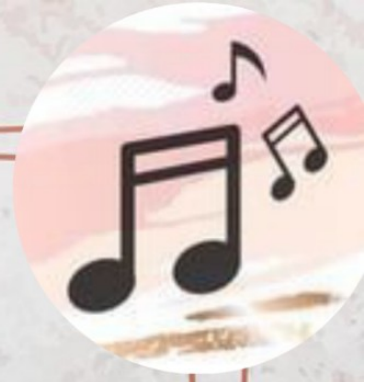

## RULES & REGULATIONS

2) Participants can also create music through any household items available, for example- music through cups, utensils, bottles, etc.

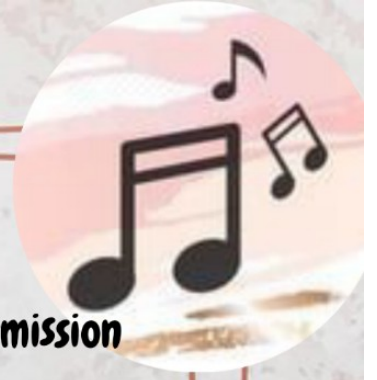
3) Participants are required to send a video of their performances. The video should be shot in one continuous take.

4) The duration of the video should be minimum 03 minutes and maximum 05 minutes for any style of performance.

5) Participants should refrain from using special effects or re-authoring the video. Re-edited videos would be disqualified.

6) Only your original work should be sent in the form of a video recording. Use of others' work without permission will automatically disqualify a submission.





**7) While Filming others, always obtain explicit permission from the person who will appear in your video**

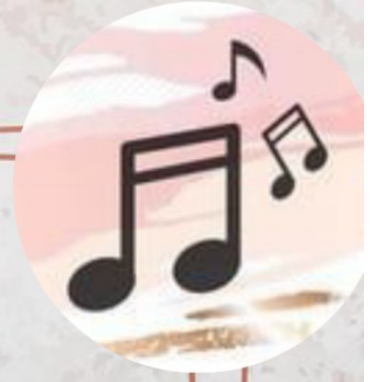
**8) No offensive or sensitive content would be tolerated. This includes religious or anti/religious, racial, political, obscene, violent, or pornographic content.**

**9) Don't film companies' logos. Do not include any logos, trademarks, designs, or other intellectual property or commercial property in your video. You may not use the video for commercial solicitation or other promotional material, advertisements, or personal solicitations, including referencing your or someone else's company contact details.**

**10) Participants are required to Maintain sound quality. Record in a quiet place and avoid distortion and ensure that the sound of the instrument should not be louder.**

**11) The video must clearly show the player/instrumentalist (including the hands) and the instruments.**

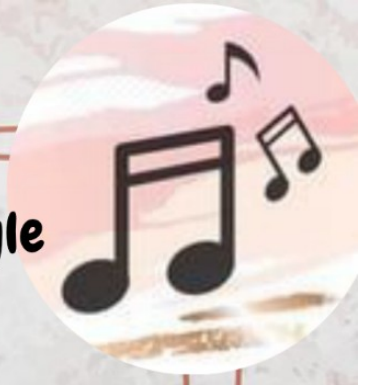
